

Choose "MyPlate" for You and Your Family!

MyPlate is a tool that can help you learn about eating a balanced diet. The plate is based on five main food groups: Grains, Vegetables, Fruits, Protein (Meat & Beans) and Dairy. Each section of the plate shows a different food group. Eating a variety of foods and in the right amounts will give you the nutrients that you need to stay healthy. Although you may not use a plate to serve your meal, the recommended amount and proportion are still useful guides for healthy eating. Balancing calories

- Enjoy your food, but eat less
- Avoid oversized portions


Foods to increase

- Make half of your plate fruits and vegetables
- Make at least half your grains whole grains
- Switch to fat-free or low-fat (1%) milk

Foods to reduce

- Compare sodium in foods like soup, bread, and frozen meals – and choose the foods with lower numbers
- Drink water instead of sugary drinks
